WHY DOES EBTN NEED AN ACCREDITATION SYSTEM?

- EBTN, as a European Network of Banking Associations and Banking Institutes, has been committed since many years to provide quality training and quality certificates to the banking sector and -more broadly- to the financial service sector.
- It seemed therefore natural, when preparing the CERTIFIED project proposal, to include the development of an accreditation model to guarantee that training bodies, training programmes and certifying bodies allowed to participate in the EBTN Certificates and Qualifications operation would have gone through a process of Quality Assurance (Q.A.).

WHAT SHOULD BE ACCREDITED?

- **Priority 1:** Accreditation of Examination Centres
- **Priority 2:** Accreditation of Training programmes leading to EBTN certificates
- **Priority 3:** Accreditation of Training Providers

Accreditation of Examination Centres

The Centres that will be accredited need to be capable of delivering the EBTN certificates and to be fully equipped in terms of:

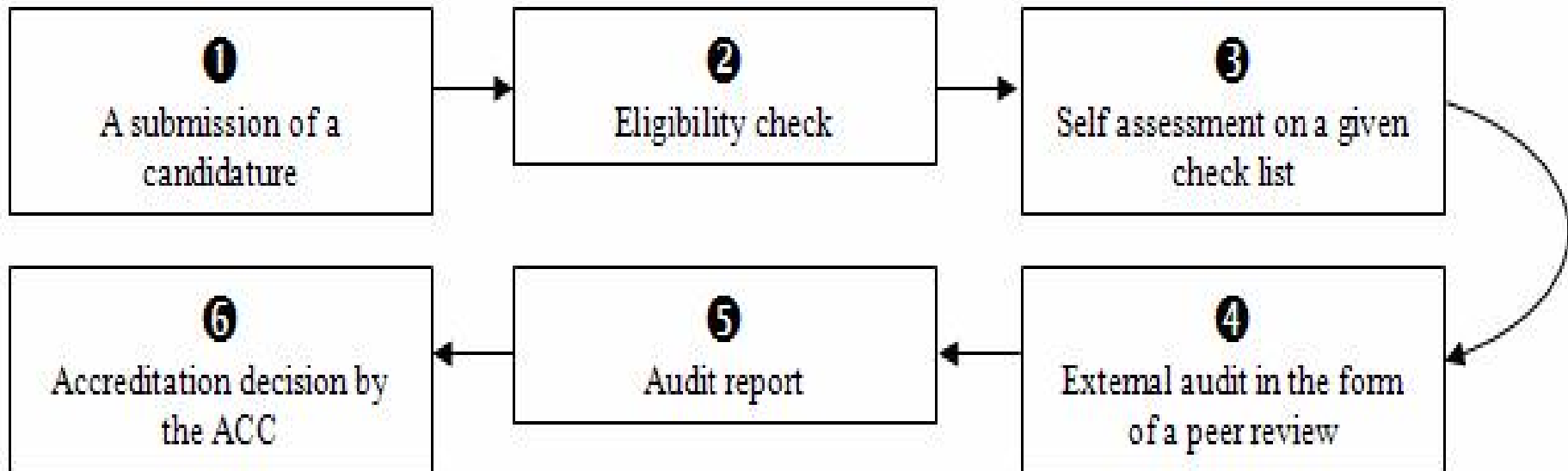
- expertise related to the Banking Sector
- expertise in delivering the Certification and using the tools necessary for evaluating
- knowledge and experience in evaluating the candidates from a Competence point of view, related to the Job profile or the competence area they are certifying

Accreditation of Examination Centres - Criteria

1. they have a CERTIFIED coordinator
2. They have suitable staff with the expertise for undertaking the assessment and certification of CERTIFIED programmes
3. They should have the ability to deploy sufficient financial, technical and staffing resources
4. They have a system for storing information on CERTIFIED programmes
5. They have a process for assessment
6. They have in their processes ensured access and equality of opportunity

ACCREDITATION OF EC - PROCEDURE

- The following scheme synthesises the proposed procedure for the accreditation of EC:



Accreditation of Training programmes leading to EBTN certificates

- Training programmes to be accredited by EBTN should only be the ones that prepare to get an EBTN certificate/qualification.

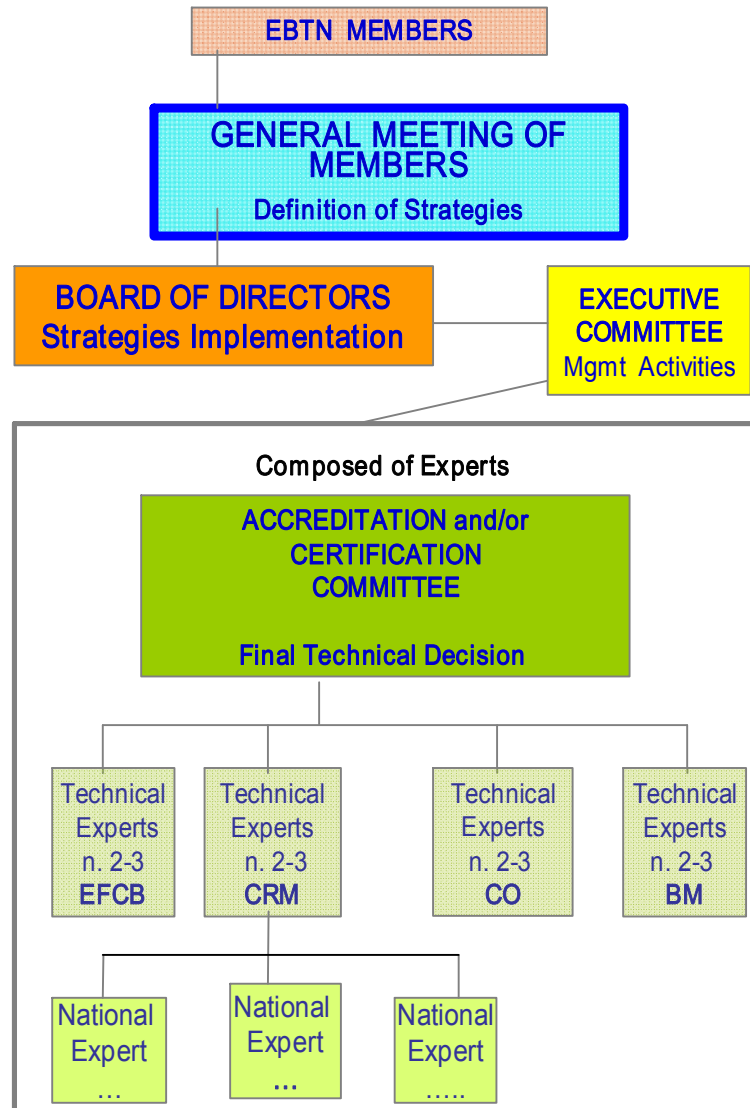
Accreditation of Training programmes leading to EBTN certificates - Criteria

1. Aims and objectives
2. Level and Qualification
3. Target Group
4. Programme Content
5. Programme structure
6. Assessment
7. Fathering Process
8. Promotion

Accreditation of Training Providers

- The Institute or other body seeking Institutional Accreditation should be able to evidence that they have the capacity and ability to deliver programmes to CERTIFIED requirements.(has the capacity to operate competence based training programmes which meet the CERTIFIED requirements and aim to obtain CERTIFIED certificates)
